## Award Details

Three scholarships are available: One at **\$5,000** and two at **\$1,500**.

Available to any student living in or attending post-secondary education in TRCA's jurisdiction, in a degree or diploma program in an area broadly related to the environment or history. Examples of fields of study could include: Environmental Studies, Landscape Architecture, Archaeology, Museum Studies, Forestry, Civil Engineering or just about any program that relates to the core work of TRCA and supports the idea of The Living City.

Students will be asked to complete this application form and provide a 500 word essay outlining how they demonstrate the values of The Living City – where human settlement can flourish forever as part of nature's beauty and diversity.

Special consideration will be given to those students who demonstrate leadership through volunteer and extracurricular activities. While marks are a consideration, the awards will not necessarily go to the student with the highest marks. Rather, we are looking for well-rounded leaders who are active in their communities and epitomize the ideals of sustainability.

Submissions will be reviewed by a volunteer selection committee of The Living City Foundation whose decisions shall be final.

Applications are due prior to September 30th. Three finalists will be invited to attend The Living City Environmental Dinner on November 3rd, 2016 where the scholarships will be awarded to each of the three.
